Men

Central Prison (Raleigh)

- Felons age 22 and older with sentences greater than 20 years (Fair) or 120 months minimum (Structured)
- Other diversions as needed

Piedmont CI (Salisbury)

- Felony offenders from Western/Piedmont counties, age 22 and older

Craven CI (Vanceboro)

- Felony offenders from Eastern/Central counties, age 22 and older

Polk CI (Butner)

- Felons age 19–26

Western Youth Institution (Morganton)

- Felons age 18 and younger
- Misdemeanants age 13–22

Neuse CI (Goldsboro)

- Misdemeanants age 22 and older.

Women

N.C. Correctional Institution for Women (Raleigh)

- Felons
- Misdemeanants with medical or mental health issues

Fountain Correctional Center for Women (Rocky Mount)

- Female misdemeanants except those with medical or mental health issues
