

Three Criminal Trials
Evidence Scenarios: Co-Defendants, Accomplices, and Co-Conspirators

TRIAL ONE

RWDW

Defendant is charged with two robberies. The State calls Moe Malloy as a witness. Moe is a co-defendant also charged with the two robberies. He testifies for the State that he and the defendant committed the robberies to obtain money to buy drugs. He further testifies that the defendant held the gun and that he searched the victims' pockets and purse.

TRIAL TWO

Murder

Defendant and his brother Bubba are charged with murder of the defendant's landlord, Mr. Moneybags. The defendant's girlfriend, Butter Woodenmelt, is charged with Accessory After the Fact to Murder. Woodenmelt testifies that she dropped the Defendant and Bubba off at Moneybags' home so Defendant could talk to Moneybags about his past due rent and when she picked them up an hour later, Defendant had blood on his shirt and Bubba showed her \$3000 in cash.

TRIAL THREE

B&E/Larceny

Jack and Jill are on trial for breaking in to three houses on UpTheHill Drive, all on October 4. Sincere represents Jill and Onthespot represents Jack. The State calls Pale O'Water, who testifies that he was with Jack and Jill and participated in the break-ins, and that Jack had 3 televisions in his possession after all the break-ins.
