- Funding stream
- Internal SOG administrative structure

■ What it's not

- Building
- New organization
- Leviathan
- All the SOG does for judges
 - Conferences, consulting, writing

Judicial College Funding

- \$1 million, recurring funding
- Mostly personnel
- Program funds
- Not mileage or motels

Types of 'College' Programs

- Orientation programs
- Seminars (e.g., sentencing seminar)
- Advanced skills programs (e.g., small claims schools)
- Cross-functional programs (JDEP)
- Topical programs (capital litigation seminar)
- **Not** associational meetings/conferences
