Need ID in 2016?

Registered voters who do not have one of the forms of photo identification that are described on the back of this card are now able to obtain a **FREE NC DMV** issued ID card.

Where can I get a free **NC DMV ID** card?

DMV Visit your local DMV office or visit a mobile
 DMV office to obtain a free **NC DMV ID** card.

What do I need to bring to get a free **NC DMV ID** card?



① Two documents that prove your age and identity (examples: a birth certificate, court documents, tax forms);

② A valid social security number; and

③ A document to prove your North Carolina residency (examples: a lease, voter registration card, utility bill).

What if I don't have a birth certificate?

To obtain a free birth or marriage certificate for the purposes of voting, please contact your local *Register of Deeds* or the *North Carolina Office of Vital Statistics* at 919-733-3000. If you were born or married out-of-state, contact that state's vital records office to receive a certified copy of the requested document.

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Beginning in 2016, you will need a photo identification card to vote in North Carolina.

ACCEPTABLE PHOTO ID STARTING IN 2016

NC Driver's License, Learner's Permit, or Provisional License

Special Identification card (*NC DMV ID Card*)

US Passport

US military identification card

US Veterans Identification card issued by the Department of Veterans Affairs

Tribal enrollment card issued by a federally-recognized tribe

Tribal enrollment card issued by an NC-recognized tribe, signed by an elected tribal official, and compliant with G.S. 163-166.13

Out-of-state driver's license or non-operator's identification card (**BUT** only if the voter registration date in the county is within 90 days of the election)

(Subject to certain exceptions, photo ID must be unexpired.)

If you do not have one of these forms of photo identification, you can apply for a free *NC DMV ID card* at your local DMV office.
