

- 1. Fairness & equity, protect constitutional rights of children and parents
- Consider facts, child's needs & limitations, and the strength & weaknesses of the family
- protect children, right to family autonomy and the children's need for safety, continuity, & permanence
- 4. Prevent unnecessary or inappropriate separation of children and their parents
- Ensure BIC are paramount consideration by the court; if not returned home, safe permanent home w/in reasonable period of time.







#### May order



- Responsible party to comply with 122C-142.2
- Pay reasonable hospital charges (after no longer medically necessary)
- Pay property damage (after no longer medically necessary)
- Any appropriate relief
- Parties bear own costs
