State v. Robinson (2025) - No. COA24-735 - Fillers

State v. Grimes, 309 N.C. 606 (1983) – To avoid improper suggestion, investigators must FAIRLY administer lineup in a manner that does nothing to induce the witness to select one participant rather than another.

State v. Tutt, 171 N.C. App. 518 (2005) – Fillers don't have to be identical to suspect's appearance to pass muster.

PHOTO SHOW-UPS

State v. Simpson (2024) No. COA23-618 – EIRA doesn't apply to photo show-up because not for same purpose as covered by EIRA.

State v. Crumitie, 266 N.C. App 373 (2019) – Photo Show-Up was not a show-up

State v. Morris, 288 N.C. App 65 (2023) – Photo Show-Ups not allowed under EIRA, but EIRA doesn't apply.
