I, Ethel C. Shealy, domiciled in Halifax County, North Carolina, declare this instrument to be my last will hereby revoking all wills and codicils heretofore made by me.

ARTICLE I

I direct that all of my just debts, my funeral expenses, including the cost of a suitable monument at my grave, and the cost of administration of my estate be paid out of the assets of my estate as soon as practicable after my death.

ARTICLE II

In the event that I am the legal owner of the house and residence located at 111 Park Drive, Enfield, Halifax County, North Carolina, at the time of my death, I devise said real property to my Executor hereinafter named and direct that said real estate be sold and the net proceeds, after paying costs of sale, be divided between Ethel Darnell Keeter, Jesse Darrell Taylor and Brenda Shealy, in equal shares. I direct that my Executor hereafter named shall have authority to conduct the sale of said property in such manner and under such terms as my Executor may determine for the best interest of my estate, without the requirement of obtaining court approval.

I will, devise, bequeath and direct my Executor to pay the sum of \$500.00 to each of the following persons who survive me: Barry Robert Lewis and Elton Lee Lewis.

ARTICLE V

I hereby constitute and appoint as recipients of any interest which I may have at the time of my death in and to the assets of the Erby R. Shealy Trust, as provided in Item Three, Section 8 of the last will of Erby R. Shealy, which is probated with the Halifax County Clerk of Superior Court, as follows: the first \$2,000.00 unto David Shealy, and the rest and remainder of said trust assets to be equally divided between and among Ethel Darnell Keeter, Jesse Darrell Taylor, Betty S. Adams and Brenda Sue Shealy.

ARTICLE VI

I hereby will, devise and bequeath all of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, of whatever kind and wherever

ARTICLE VII

I hereby constitute and appoint Balfour Ray Keeter, Jr. as Executor of this my last will. In the event that Balfour Ray Keeter, Jr. is unable to serve, decides not to serve or for any reason ceases to complete the administration of my estate, I hereby appoint David Ray Keeter as Substitute Executor of this my last will. My personal representative is to serve without the requirement of bond.

I, Ethel Shealy, the Testatrix, sign my name to this instrument this 29th day of July, 2015, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my last will and that I sign it willingly, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am eighteen years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.
