

- Substitution (not assistance)
- Customarily an attorney

  - 2 people, 2 roles
     Does not impact right to counsel
- Non-parent respondents?

# Category 1a: Minor parents at TPR

Required for any parent < 18 who is not married or emancipated



G.S. 7B-1101.1(b)

### Category 1b: Minor parents at AND

- Required for any parent < 16
- $\bullet\,$  Court's discretion for 16 17  $\,$  who is not married or emancipated
- Initiated by motion or sua sponte

## Category 2: Incompetent parents

- · Don't skip Step 1
- Incompetency ≠
  - Difficult personality
  - · Cultural differences\*
  - Language barriers
  - Confusion, deficits, or diagnoses alone

A Second Look at In re A.K., Addressing Cultural Issues in A/N/D Cases

The North Carolina Court of Appeals in <u>Int XA.K.</u>, N.C. App. (Aug. 6, 2024) addressed a parents right to be represented by a privately retained attorney of their choosing in an abuse, neglect, and dependency (AVND) action. Over the course of Calendary year 2022, 18,885 children in North Carolina were in the custody of a county department of social services (DSS), Statistics identify the race of those children. The majority of children in DSS custody (Sa39) were white. Amost one out of three children (P2-38) were black. The remaining children were Hispanic (B,59%), Native American (3%), or "other race" (11,48%), Ser Child Welfare Statistics (Beg.) There are, of course, other aspects of culture such as religion and national origin that are not identified in these statistics. Yet, we know that families from all races, ethnicities, religions, socioeconomic status, and more are involved in North Carolina's child welfare system.

# Category 2: Incompetent parents Substantial question? Inquiry or hearing. • Significant deference to trial court • No formal procedures, but... • Notice • Evidence (lay, expert, docs) • Observation + voir dire
