BASIS FOR DEVIATION

- GUIDELINE AMOUNT DOES NOT MEET OR EXCEEDS THE CHILD'S NEEDS CONSIDERING RELATIVE ABILITY OF EACH PARENT TO PROVIDE SUPPORT
- GUIDELINE AMOUNT IS OTHERWISE UNJUST OR INAPPROPRIATE
