A Note About Language

"Juvenile"

Legal term used in child welfare and juvenile justice laws (G.S. 7B)

A person under 18 who is not emancipated, married, or in the Armed Forces

"Minor"

Legal term used in public health/health laws (G.S. 90 + 130A)

A person under 18 who is not emancipated or married

For our purposes today, "juvenile" and "minor" typically mean the same thinga person under 18 (who the law doesn't treat as an adult because of emancipation, marriage, etc.)



A Note About Language

"Child"

A person age 1 to 11*

"Adolescent"

A person age 12 to 19*

*This depends on who you ask. CDC, the World Health Organization, and others use slightly different age ranges to describe childhood and adolescence.
