


Cost Burden Share by Region

COST BURDEN BY COUNTY 2017






Barriers to Mobility

 - Lack of access to supports such as childcare & transportation


Children's Chances of Reaching Top 20% of Income Distribution Given Parents in Bottom 20%





Educational Attainment for the Region




Median Annual Earnings and Gender Earnings Ratio, North Carolina Counties, 2016


Disconnected Youth








Regional Business Establishment Change Relative to 2010

Regional Employment Compared to State as Percentage Change Relative to 2010




