Name that Track Scenarios

TSP

- Parent agrees to TSP
- Petition is filed while juvenile remains in TSP
- What information do you need to determine which track?

Other Parent

- Child resides with mom and is removed by nonsecure custody
- Child is adjudicated
- Initial disposition orders custody to dad and ceases reunification efforts with mom
- Which track?

Caretaker and DSS

- Child is with caretaker when petition filed
- Nonsecure custody with DSS obtained
- Child is adjudicated
- Initial disposition continues child in DSS custody
- Which track?

Caretaker only

- Child is with caretaker when petition filed regarding circumstances created by mother in abandoning child
- Nonsecure not sought
- Child adjudicated neglected due to circumstances related to mother
- Initial disposition orders custody to caretaker

Parent after PPH

- In a case where permanent custody was ordered to a relative and further hearings were waived, parent files motion for a 7B-906.1 hearing PPH.
- After the PPH, with consent of parties and findings by court, an order is entered that returns the child to the custody of parent. Court wants another hearing in 6 months.
- Which track does the case proceed on?
