


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### Customizations for North Carolina

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# PARENTS, GUARDIANS, CUSTODIAN'S ROLE IN VULNERABLE JUVENILE CONSULTATIONS SERVICES Juvenile Court Counselor may: • Provide Case Management Services • Transport the parent, guardian, or custodian and the juvenile to keep an appointment or to comply with the recommendations of the juvenile court counselor. • With written orders or recommendations from a qualified mental or physical health provider the JCC: • Recommend psychiatric, psychological, or other evaluation or treatment or counseling for the PGC that are directed toward remedying behaviors or conditions that led to or cornitoted to the juvenile consultation. • Recommend and assist parent, guardian, or custodian with seeking funding through the Division of Juvenile justice and/or the IME/MCC to ply the cost of any covaluation or treatment including helping them apply for Medicaid/Heakth Choice

### FOR JUVENILES ELIGIBLE FOR LEVEL 3 COMMITMENT AND PLACEMENT IN PRTF

- · Juvenile has been adjudicated delinquent
- Juvenile with  $\underline{suspected}$  mental illness (MI), developmental disability (DD), or intellectual disability (ID)
- or intellectual disability (IID)

  Tools to help us determine if there is suspected MI, DD, ID

  GAINASS Score of 3 or more total score

  Referral for further assessment

  YASI

  Mental Health Information/MH Records (psychological or other MH assessments)

  Self or Parent Report

  Requiris ICC to make preferal for a CCA
- Require JCC to make a referral for a CCA or equivalent MH Assessment
- Completed within 45 days of adjudication hearing
- $\begin{tabular}{ll} Assessment must evaluate developmental, emotional, behavioral, \& mental health needs of juvenile \end{tabular}$

### CARE REVIEW FACILITATION AND COORDINATION SERVICES

- Court Services is working to hire a Care Review Facilitators to coordinate and assist JCC with care review process
  JCC will immediately notify Care Review Facilitator when juvenile is eligible for Level 3 Commitment or placement in PRTF
  Send copy of current CCA or inform Care Review Facilitator date of referral for CCA. Send copy of CCA to Facilitator once completed.
- Inform Care Review Facilitator date adjudication hearing is scheduled or may be scheduled
- Begin working with Facilitator to start the Care Review Process
- Work with the Care Review Facilitator to convene the Care Review Team


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



- · Detention Assessment Tool (DAT) findings.
- · Severity of offense.
- · Nature of the circumstances.
- YASI (Youth Assessment & Screening Instrument)\*
- · Juvenile's behavior (school attendance, ability to return to school, home behavior, runaway behavior, etc.).
- Supervision within the home and a plan for supervision, including the need for Electronic Monitoring (EM).
- Juvenile's and family's compliance history with previous ATD and supervision requirements, if
- Need for mental health or substance abuse treatment and the availability of appropriate resources outside of detention.
