- 1960 Thirty for all purposes
 - Six one-county districts, two seven-county
- 2015
 - District Court 44 districts for elections
 - District Court 41 for administration
 - 15 one-county districts; two seven-county



JUDICIAL DISTRICTS, 1960-2000

- 1960
 - Largest 272,000 (Mecklenburg)
 - Smallest 73,000 (1st, 6th, and 24th)
 - o Ratio 4/1
 - Average size 151,871
- 2015 (estimated)
 - Largest 1.034 million (26th), 1.024 million (10th)
 - Smallest 62,000 (9A); 60,700 (20A)
 - o Ratio 17/1
 - Average size 228,000






