Dear Judge [REDACTED]:

This letter is to document our conversation last Friday about the procedural posture and jurisdiction of this case as required by North Carolina General Statute §50A-206(b) and §50A-110. None of the attorneys or parties were present for our conversation.

After reviewing our respective files, we agree that [REDACTED] filed an action in Wake County, North Carolina in September 2016 [REDACTED]. There were two Complaints for Domestic Violence Protection filed by [REDACTED] and the minor child in Wake County in 2016. The parties reached a consent, and Orders have been entered, concerning Equitable Distribution (July 2017) and Child Support (April 2017). The parties were also divorced in North Carolina in 2018. The divorce judgment is entered in Wake County [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] has moved and relocated to Maine with the children. She has a pending action for custody in Maine. [REDACTED] continues to reside in North Carolina.

There have been multiple temporary custody orders entered in North Carolina, the most recent being a consent order entered February 13, 2018. A hearing on permanent custody was scheduled in August 2018, but it was continued in order to permit our discussion regarding jurisdiction.

We agree that North Carolina has continuing exclusive jurisdiction until this Court declines to exercise jurisdiction. We agree that a hearing should be held in North Carolina concerning jurisdiction. I will ask the Family Court office to schedule this hearing and provide notice to all parties.

We will forward any new custody or jurisdictional orders to your office upon entry. Please forward any new orders from your Court to the Wake County Family Court Office at the address listed above.

Thank you for your time. I enjoyed speaking with you and I look forward to perhaps talking with you again someday in the future.
