Dear Judge [REDACTED]:

This letter is to document our conversation this morning about the procedural posture and jurisdiction of this case as required by North Carolina General Statute §50A-206(b) and §50A-110. None of the attorneys or parties were present for our conversation.

After reviewing our respective files, we agree that Mr. [REDACTED] filed an action in Wake County, North Carolina on February 8, 2018. Ms. [REDACTED] was served with the North Carolina action on April 13, 2018. Mr. [REDACTED] also filed two previous actions in North Carolina in 2017 that have been dismissed by the Court (Case No. [REDACTED]). There is no current North Carolina order in effect.

Ms. [REDACTED] filed an action in Garfield County, Colorado on February 21, 2018. Mr. [REDACTED] was served with the Colorado action on March 20, 2018. Ms. [REDACTED] has filed a motion to waive mediation in Colorado.

Both parties seem to agree that Ms. [REDACTED] and the children have been living in Colorado for more than six months, since June 2017.

We agree that it is appropriate to have an evidentiary hearing regarding jurisdiction, during which the parties may be heard about the facts and circumstances affecting jurisdiction.

I intend to enter a temporary stay of the North Carolina action until an evidentiary hearing takes place in your Court in Colorado. The parties will be asked to coordinate a date for the jurisdictional hearing with the Family Court Facilitator in Garfield County. Once a date is chosen, the parties will have the opportunity to appear, and Mr. [REDACTED] may request to appear by telephone if he chooses.

Please forward any new orders from your Court to the Wake County Family Court Office at the address listed above.

Thank you for your time. I enjoyed speaking with you and I look forward to perhaps talking with you again someday in the future.
