## SO WHERE DOES PROBATIONARY PERIOD FIT IN?

- Still required by administrative rule
- No longer signals onset of property interest
- May, on a county to county basis, control access to benefits, regulate some compensation aspects

### WHAT IS CAREER STATUS?

- 1. 24 Months of
- 2. Continuous service
- In a position subject to the State Personnel Act

# WHAT DIFFERENCE DOES IT MAKE?

- "Protected" vs. "unprotected"
- Property Interest vs. at-will
- Due Process

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

- New hire
- Transfer within county different agency
- Move from County A to County B
- "Break in Service"
