

SPEED LIMITATIONS ON BRIDGES, CAUSEWAYS, AND VIADUCTS. G.S. 20-144.

The motor vehicle law provides that a special speed limitation applies to a public [bridge] [causeway] [viaduct] when it is sign-posted by the Department of Transportation as to the posted maximum speed. In such case, it is the duty of a motorist not to drive upon such [bridge] [causeway] [viaduct] at a speed greater than the posted maximum speed. In this case the posted maximum speed was *(state posted speed)*.¹

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

¹The findings and determination of the Department of Transportation shall be conclusive evidence of the maximum speed which can with safety to any such structure be maintained.
