RAILWAY CROSSINGS -- STOP SIGN. G.S. 20-143.

The motor vehicle law provides that at a railroad crossing where a stop sign is erected, the operator of a vehicle must stop within fifty feet, but not less than ten feet, from the nearest rail of such railroad and shall proceed only upon exercising due care.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.
