MEETING OF VEHICLES. G.S. 20-148.

The motor vehicle law provides that the operators of vehicles proceeding in opposite directions shall pass each other to the right, each giving to the other at least one-half of the main-traveled portion of the roadway as nearly as possible.<sup>2</sup>

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.
