

TURNING AT INTERSECTION<sup>1</sup>--CONTROLLED BY BUTTONS, MARKERS OR OTHER DIRECTION  
SIGNS. G.S. 20-153(c).

The motor vehicle law provides that the operator of a vehicle turning at an intersection<sup>2</sup> must follow the route which has been clearly indicated by the [buttons] [markers] [(name other direction signs)] placed at the intersection by the [Board of Transportation] [(name local authority)].<sup>3</sup>

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

<sup>1</sup>Use this instruction only where the Board of Transportation or a local authority has modified the normal methods of turning at an intersection (see N.C.P.I.--Civil 209.10 (Right Turn) and 209.15 (Left Turn)) by clearly indicating a different method by buttons, markers or other directional signs.
