EMERGENCY VEHICLES--PARKING WITHIN 100 FEET OF EMERGENCY VEHICLE. G.S. 20-157(e).

The motor vehicle law provides that it is unlawful for the driver of a vehicle [other than one on official business] to park and leave standing such vehicle within 100 feet of (a) [[police]¹[law enforcement]²] [fire department] [public ambulance] [private ambulance] [rescue squad emergency service] vehicle(s) which (is) (are) engaged in the investigation of an accident or engaged in rendering assistance to victims of such accident.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.
