

DUTY OF FOLLOWING MOTORIST WHEN VEHICLE HAS STOPPED FOR PEDESTRIAN.
G.S. 20-173(b).

The motor vehicle law provides that when a vehicle is stopped at [a marked crosswalk] [an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection]¹ in order to permit a pedestrian to cross the roadway, the operator of a vehicle approaching the stopped vehicle from the rear shall not overtake and pass it.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.
