

SECURING LOADS--OPEN FLAT TRUCKS. G.S. 20-120.¹

The motor vehicle law provides that it is unlawful to operate on any highway any open, flat truck loaded with [logs] [cotton bales] [boxes] [(describe other load)] without having the load securely fastened on the truck.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

¹Trucks hauling tobacco are governed by other provisions of G.S. 20-120, not included in the above instruction.

As to dropping, sifting and leaking loads on any vehicle, see G.S. 20-116(g).
