

CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAY--CROSSING CENTRAL DIVIDING LINE. G.S. 20-140.3(1).

The motor vehicle law provides that it is unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to drive over, upon or across a [center curb] [central dividing section] [center separation or dividing line] on any controlled-access highway.¹

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

¹The statute applies to both interstate and other controlled-access highways.
