CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAY--FAILURE TO YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY. G.S. 20-140.3(6).

The motor vehicle law provides that the operator of a vehicle entering any controlled-access highway shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle already travelling on the highway.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

¹The statute applies to both interstate or other controlled-access highways.
