COASTING PROHIBITED. G.S. 20-165.

The motor vehicle law provides that the operator of a motor vehicle shall not travel upon a down grade [with the gears or transmission of such vehicle in neutral] [with the clutch of such vehicle disengaged].

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.  $^{1}$
