259.80 MISUSE OF 911 SYSTEM. MISDEMEANOR.

The defendant has been charged with misuse of the 911 system.

For you to find the defendant guilty of this offense, the State must prove two things beyond a reasonable doubt.

First, that the defendant was not [seeking public safety assistance] [providing 911 service] [responding to a 911 call].

Second, that the defendant knowingly [accessed] [attempted to access] the 911 system for a purpose other than an emergency communication.

If you find from the evidence beyond a reasonable doubt that on or about the alleged date the defendant knowingly [accessed] [attempted to access] the 911 system for a purpose other than an emergency communication and was not [seeking public safety assistance] [providing 911 service] [responding to a 911 call], it would be your duty to return a verdict of guilty. If you do not so find or have a reasonable doubt as to one or more of these things, it would be your duty to return a verdict of not guilty.
