Program Description: This one day workshop will provide updates on HIPAA compliance issues for local health departments, focusing on topics recommended by the training committee of the NC Public Health HIPAA Alliance, an informal collaboration of NC local health department HIPAA officers. Topics will include maintaining robust security measures with new technologies; managing behavioral health information; understanding school health confidentiality taking into account both HIPAA and FERPA; and managing disclosures when a patient has a personal representative responsible for the individual's health care.
