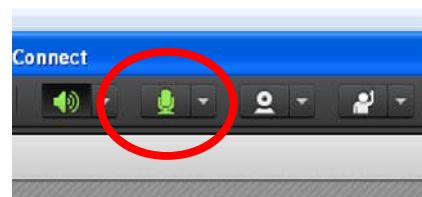
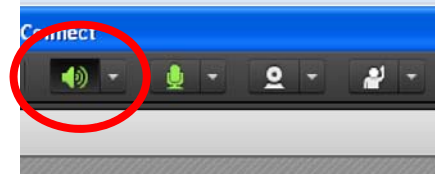
## How to Vote?

### Tables

### Integrated Data Systems and Recordkeeping

- Pilot rollouts by region
- Regular reports
- p. 17/12

### Workforce development

- “Staffing Standards and Support”
- p. 19/16

## Staffing Model

### Staffing model (p. 23/18)

- Regional Administrator → Regional Director
- Stronger language about shifting positions from central to regional offices

### Mapping (p. 26/20)

- Explicit recommendation for 5-7 regions
- Explain that number of regions can grow once infrastructure in place

### Involvement of local officials (p. 28/22)

- Language clarified in several sections

## Accountability




- Cross-references other areas of the report that relate to accountability of regional offices (p.33/27)
- Adds new recommendation
  - "...the SSWG recommends that DHHS establish a formal mechanism to allow the local social services directors and county managers to provide direct feedback to central office staff on the performance of the regional office and the regional director."
