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

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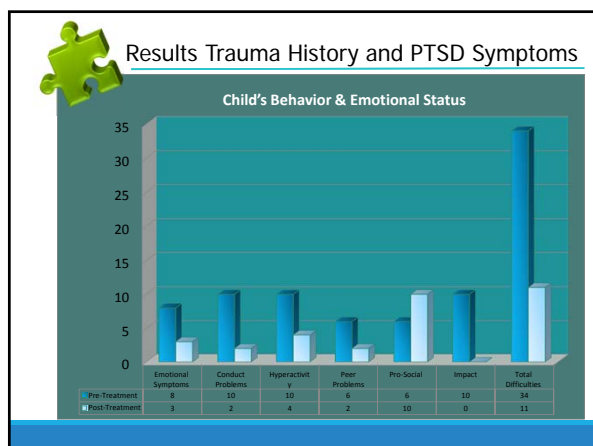
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Signs of Safety Practice Model

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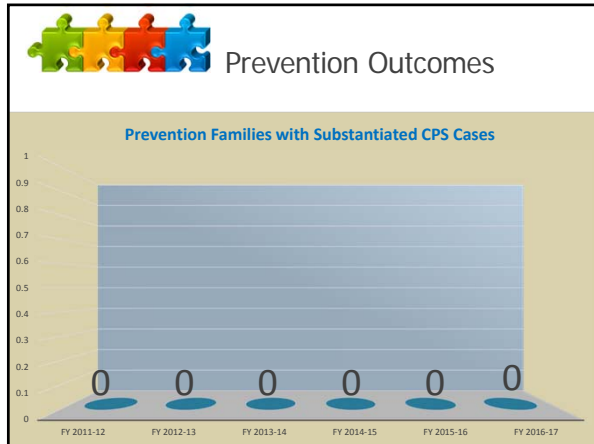
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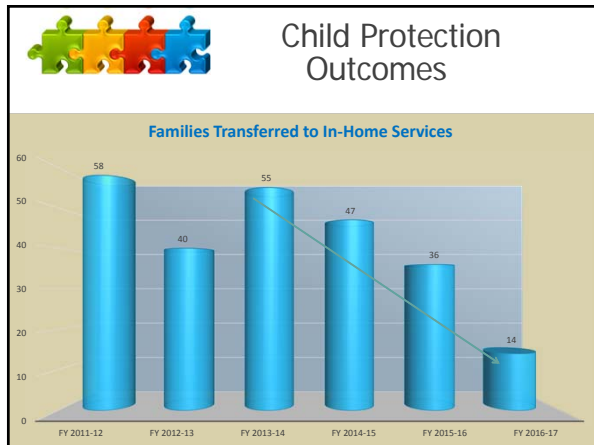
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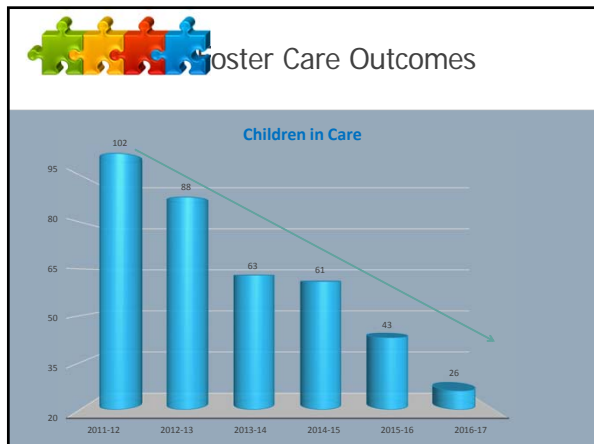
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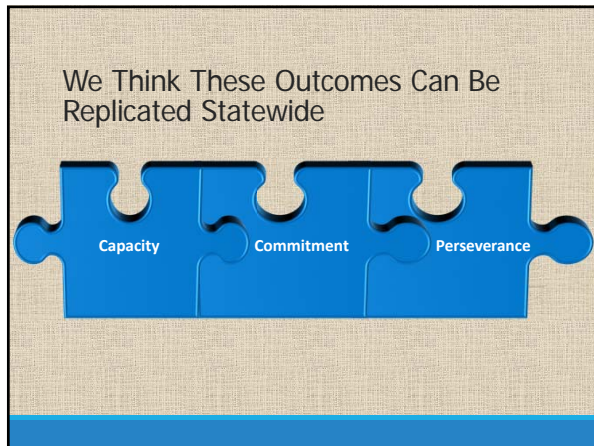
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## Family First Prevention Services Act

**Opens Title IV-E For Specified Prevention Services:**

- Mental Health And Substance Abuse Services
- In-home Parent Skill-Based Programs

**Services Can Be Given For Up To 12 Months To:**

- A Child Who Is A Candidate For Foster Care
- A Child Is Pregnant Or Parenting
- A Parent Or Kin Caregiver

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## Recommendations For Statewide Replication

- ASSIST COUNTIES TO BUILD THE CAPACITY
- MAXIMIZE FAMILY SUPPORT ACT FUNDING
- IDENTIFY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FUNDING FOR CUSTOMIZED CHILD WELFARE CLINICAL SERVICES AND TRAUMA INFORMED INTERVENTIONS
- INCENTIVIZE MULTI-COUNTY SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENTS




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

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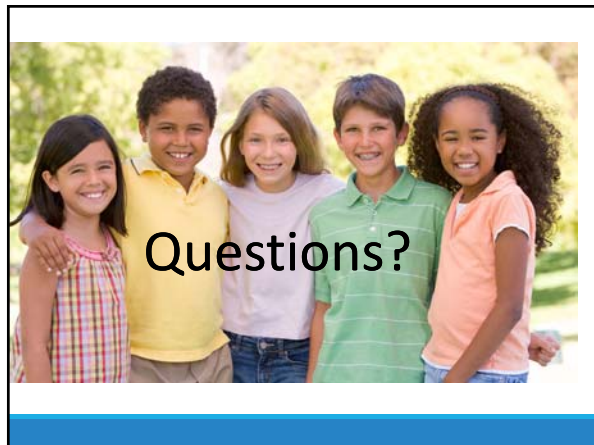
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
