

Canvas Login Instructions

You can sign-in to the School of Government's new learning management system Canvas in three easy steps outlined below.

Step 1: Set Up Your Password

When you log in to Canvas for the first time, you need to set your password. You only need to do this once.

Remember your password for future School of Government courses.

Go to https://sso.sog.unc.edu/user/password and enter your email. This should be the same email that you used to register for the course.





Step 2: Follow the Reset Password Instructions

Upon entering your email, you will see a confirmation that further instructions have been sent to your email address.

The email will have the title 'Replacement login information for placeholderforyouremail@address.com at School of Government Single Sign-On Service.' The password reset link in the email will lead you to a one-time login that will allow you to choose your password.



The email should look like this:


This is a one-time login for *liebestefanie@gmail.com*.

Click on this button to log in to the site and change your password.

This login can be used only once.

Upon setting your password, you will see a confirmation that changes have been saved. TIP: You can go through these two steps anytime you forgot your password and need to reset it.





Step 3: Sign-in to Canvas


You can now access the Canvas learning management system with your newly set password at https://sogunc.instructure.com/

Note: You will need to enter your email address and the password that you created through the steps above.

You may be asked to accept the updated user policy. Please confirm to proceed.



Once you are signed in, you will see the dashboard with your current course(s).



From now on, you can go to https://sogunc.instructure.com/ and access your learning materials. Your password will be the same for all School of Government courses.
