Summary

- Uniform statewide system.
 Trial courts: District court/Superior Court
 Appellate courts: North Carolina Court of Appeals and North Carolina Supreme Court

- Udicial selection
 Judges are elected in partisan elections
 In case of a vacancy, the governor appoints replacement
- Funding
 County (and sometimes city) pays for facilities, fixtures, and furniture
 State pays salaries and other operating expenses
