

Basic Principles to Guide You

- Public dollars can only be used for a public purpose
- Legislative office resources are public resources and cannot be used for campaign purposes
- Legislative Assistants and other legislative staff are part of your legislative office resources
- Legislative employees are also covered under LEC Principles and Guidelines ("P&Gs")
