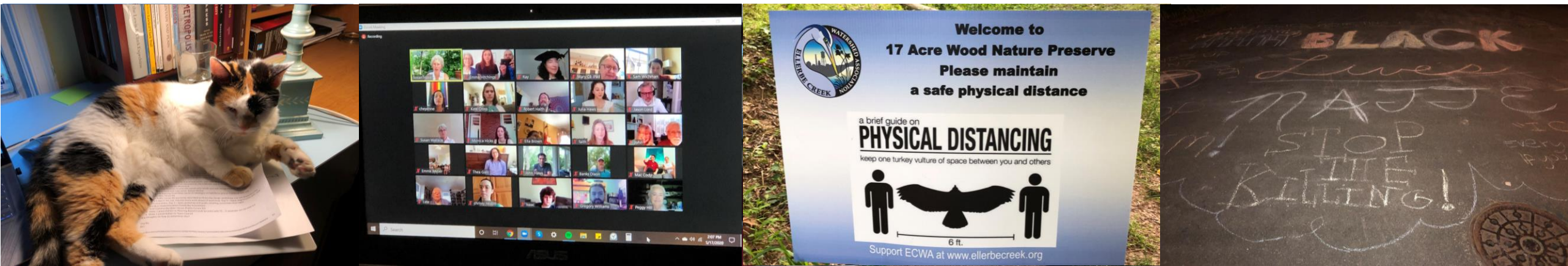

Ethical Dilemmas



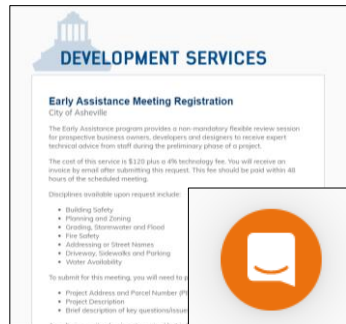
- **Call from colleague**

6. Try some thoughtful experiments

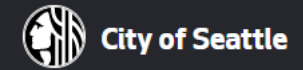

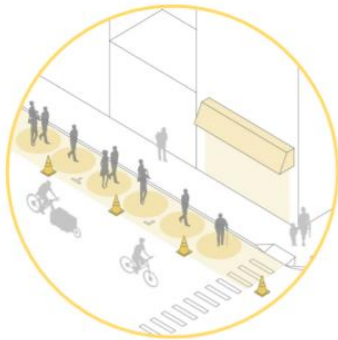

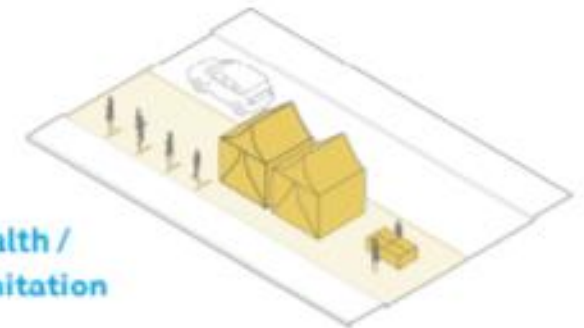
