

WILLFULLY COVERING REGISTRATION PLATE. G.S. 20-63(g).
INFRACTION.

The defendant has been charged with willfully covering a registration plate.

For you to find the defendant responsible for this infraction, the State must prove the following three things beyond a reasonable doubt.

First, that the defendant was an operator of a motor vehicle.

Second, that the defendant willfully [covered] [caused to be covered] a part or portion of a registration plate or the figures or letters on a registration plate.

And Third, that the defendant used a device [designed] [intended] to [prevent] [interfere with] the taking of a clear photograph of a registration plate by a traffic control system using cameras.

If you find from the evidence beyond a reasonable doubt that on or about the alleged date the defendant was an operator of a motor vehicle and that the defendant willfully [covered] [caused to be covered] a part or portion of a registration plate or the figures or letters on a registration plate by using a device [designed] [intended] to

[prevent] [interfere with] the taking of a clear photograph of a registration plate by a traffic control system using cameras, it would be your duty to find the defendant responsible. If you do not so find, or have a reasonable doubt as to one or more of these things, it would be your duty to return a verdict of not responsible.
